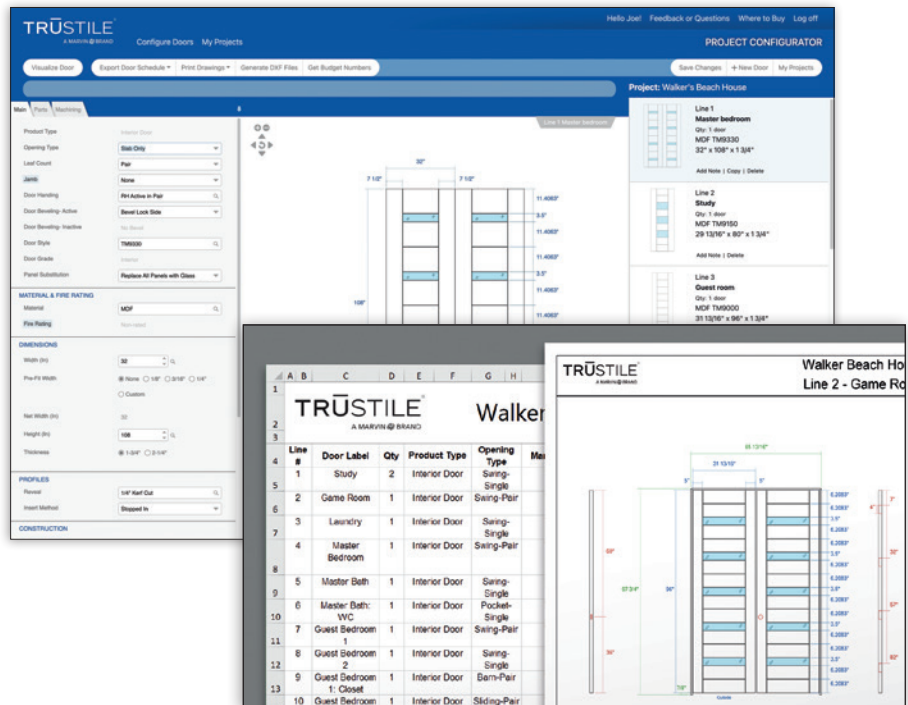


## Project Configurator
